FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council was informed that Daniel Parker was the recipient of the Department of Interior valor award, and
- WHEREAS, Daniel Parker had to travel to Washington, D. C. to receive the award from the Secretary of the Interior, Cecil Andrus, and
- WHEREAS, it was the desires of the Tribal Council to supplement his paid expenses and also supply the necessary financial assistance so that he could be accompanied by his wife, and
- WHEREAS, the agreed amount of assistance is \$750.00.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that out of the Public Relations or other contingency funds, that the Daniel Parker family receive a grant of \$750.00 to assist in defraying the expenses of transportation and lodging to the ceremonies of Washington, D. C. during the week of May 15th.


The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
