


RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has extended an invitation to the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereafter known as the Tribe, to participate in the State conducted, Federally funded, Emergency Energy Assistance Program, Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance Program for low-income persons, and Community Services Administration Emergency Energy Conservation Program, and

WHEREAS, said program funds would be used to make payment on behalf of eligible program beneficiaries, who are in need of weatherization services and assistance in fuel costs as a consequence of their inability to pay for past services rendered.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to enter into contracts with the State of Arizona, energy providers, and any other parties appropriate and necessary to participation by the Tribe in this Emergency Energy Assistance Program.

The foregoing resolution was on May 11, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
