

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires a healthful living environment for all of its people and further desires maximum practicable energy conservation, and
- WHEREAS, many tribal members living on the reservation, including the elderly and the handicapped, are unable to improve the energy efficiency of their residences due to their low-income status, and
- WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security proposes to contract with the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the purpose of providing weatherization assistance in improving the energy efficiency of dwellings belonging to low-income reservation families, including the elderly and the handicapped.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council seeks to provide a healthful living environment for its low-income reservation families, including the elderly and the handicapped and the conservation of energy resources wherever possible.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary, on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, to contract with the Arizona Department of Economic Security for weatherization assistance.


The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
