

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to establish policies for the payment of travel and per diem for personnel required to travel on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, it is their further desire that this policy shall apply to all personnel employed by the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that per diem be established at the following rates:


1. Travel within the State of Arizona, but off the reservation shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$35.00 per day. This rate shall be further broken down so that travel not requiring an overnight stay shall be paid at the rate of \$17.50 with the full amount being paid for overnight trips.
2. Travel outside the State of Arizona excluding Washington, D. C. shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$50.00 per day for those days requiring overnight accommodations and \$17.50 per day for any partial days where overnight stays are not required.
3. Travel to Washington, D. C. shall be reimbursed at the rate of \$100.00 per day.


The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
