

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, with the completion of the new Whiteriver Community Health Facility, rights-of-ways are needed for water and sewer lines, and

WHEREAS, the newest sewer line will go from the hospital area down to the Rainbow City system and behind the hill below the Baptist Church, and

WHEREAS, the waterline would come from the Diamond Creek well location and connect onto the present Diamond Creek-Rainbow City domestic water supply.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a gratuitous utility right-of-way be granted to the U. S. Public Health Service that would be 15 feet in width and a total of three lineal feet of a six-inch water main and a total of 7,101 feet of eight-inch sewerline.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Agency Superintendent be furnished the documentation required under CFR 25 for these two (2) Rights-of-Ways.


The foregoing resolution was on May 31, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
