

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed the need for an individual to be stationed in Cibecue, Arizona as a liason between the Tribal Administration and the Tribal Council for this isolated community, and
- WHEREAS, this Co-ordinator would be a member of the Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, an office would be maintained for this position in the Cibecue Community Center, and
- WHEREAS, the established salary for this position would be \$10,500.00 annually, but would not entitle the individual to the council meeting pay.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that a position of a Tribal Co-ordinator be established in the community of Cibecue to co-ordinate tribal activities and act as a liason between the Tribal Administration and the Tribal Council.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the individual selected for this position is Mr. Harley Janeway, Councilman of the Cibecue District; and that he will receive a salary of \$10,500.00 annually plus mileage at the established tribal rate, but will be excluded from the regular Tribal Council meeting payments.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this position be effective, starting Monday, June 5, 1978 and continue so long as Mr. Janeway is a member of the Tribal Council or the position is terminated by the Tribal Council.


The foregoing resolution was on May 31, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
