RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Fair Commission discussed indebtedness of the past Rodeo Association, and
- WHEREAS, this indebtedness was in excess of two thousand dollars, and
- WHEREAS, lumber was purchased from the Fort Apache Timber Company without adequate authorization, and
- WHEREAS, the council desires that this bill be accepted by the Fort Apache Timber Company as a bad debt.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Fort Apache Timber Company take the appropriate steps to consider this uncollectible and remove it from the Accounts Receivable of the Fort Apache Timber Company.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
