

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has an asphalt overlay project scheduled this summer in Cibecue to overlay all the roads in Cibecue that have been previously primed and sealed, and the road into Cibecue from Arizona State Highway 60, Routes 12, 3 and 34, and

WHEREAS, thirty-five thousand (35,000) tons of gravel is required and a gravel pit is required to process material, and

WHEREAS, gravel in Salt Creek, above the Salt Creek Bridge, to one-fourth mile beyond the Salt Creek Cemetery is recommended, and will clean the channel to prevent further flooding of the cemetery, and

WHEREAS, gravel pit will be cleaned up after use and river channel repaired.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby granted permission to remove gravel by contract and that royalty be hereby waived in lieu of benefits received.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
