

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has acknowledged the high priority of community health education in its 1978 Tribal Health Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service is not currently providing these services to the White Mountain Apache people, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Health Advisory Board on May 23, 1978 voted unanimously to develop a Tribal Health Education Program to provide comprehensive community health education services, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Chairman is authorized to negotiate a contract for these services under the Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act (P.L. 93-638), and


WHEREAS, the terms of this contract should include a starting date of August 1, 1978 and a contract period of twelve (12) months from that date.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe authorizes contract negotiations to begin immediately for the purpose of developing a Tribal Health Education Program and continue until said contract is effective.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized and directed to sign any and all documents to consummate this contract.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
