

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has an asphalt overlay project scheduled this summer from Whiteriver to Rock Creek, East Fork Mission to Fort Apache Junction, Stago Crossing, Canyon Day Streets, Fort Apache Timber Company and across Fort Apache Timber Company Bridge to Arizona State Highway 73, Routes 55, 46, 45 and 4, Whiteriver Airport and taxiway, and


WHEREAS, forty-five thousand (45,000) tons of gravel is required and a gravel pit is required, and


WHEREAS, gravel in Whiteriver below the Canyon Day Stockman's residence is recommended, and

WHEREAS, the gravel pit will be cleaned up after use and river channel repaired.

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby granted permission to remove gravel by contract and that royalty be hereby waived in lieu of benefits received.

The foregoing resolution was on June 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
