WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been requested on behalf of Davis Susan, Jr., to provide him with sufficient funds for a one-way airfare ticket to South Dakota in order that he may participate in a Junior Rodeo to which he has been specially invited; and


WHEREAS, Davis Susan, Jr., is an aspiring high school student with successful junior rodeo skills and ambitions; and is encouraged by his family who will attend said rodeo; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires to urge and encourage the productive advancement of tribal youth, such as Davis Susan, Jr.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes the tribal expenditure of sufficient funds for a one-way air fare ticket plus one week camping fee of fifty-dollars (\$50.00) for Davis Susan, Jr., said funds to be paid out of the Central Tribal Budget for General Public Relations.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1978, duly adopted by a vote of nine (9) for and zero (0) against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
