WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the attached community budget for the funds appropriated for recreation in the communities from the Land Claims Funds has been presented to the following communities in an open meeting and voting of the community residents, and:

WHEREAS, the above communities by a majority vote of those present at the community meetings have approved this proposed budget, and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Tribal Council to institute this program and budget in accordance with the desires of these communities.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached budget for the aforementioned Communities Recreation Program is approved for each Community listed.

BE IT FURTHERE RESOLVED that the funds to initiate these programs be appropriated as needed by the Central Accounting Office from the Lands Claims Funds on deposit with the United States Government in order to fund the Recreation Program in the above communities.

The foregoing resolution was on July 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


