

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the "78" Blowdown Logging Unit is not included in the five-year timber program; and

WHEREAS, this sale is necessitated by 107.5 acres of spruce blowdown within the Mount Baldy Wilderness to prevent a spruce bark beetle epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the sale contract has been prepared without a formal appraisal; and

WHEREAS, a formal appraisal will be prepared annually during the Fort Apache Timber Company reappraisal; and

WHEREAS, the "78" Blowdown Logging Unit is part of the 72 million annual allowable cut on the east side of the reservation to be cut at the Whiteriver Sawmill.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Odart Logging Unit, as presented in the proposed contract for the sale of timber and subject to minor changes and administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer be sold to the Fort Apache Timber Company as described below:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary and Chairman of the Tribal Council are authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of timber for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a deduction, not to exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the gross receipts received from the Purchaser, will be accrued in the Road Suspense Account. This accrual will continue until the Road Suspense Account is funded to the extent required to provide the road construction fund reserve authorized by the Tribe.

WHEREAS, the Odart Logging Unit is included in the five-year timber program; and

WHEREAS, the sale contract has been prepared without a formal appraisal; and

WHEREAS, a formal appraisal will be prepared annually during the Fort Apache Timber Company reappraisal; and

WHEREAS, the Odart Logging Unit is in the Maverick Timber Management Block and is part of the 72 million annual allowable cut on the east side of the reservation to be cut at the Whiteriver Sawmill.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Odart Logging Unit, as presented in the proposed contract for the sale of timber, and subject to minor changes and administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer be sold to the Fort Apache Timber Company as described below:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary and Chairman of the Tribal Council are authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of timber for and on behalf of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a deduction, not to exceed fifteen percent (15%) of the gross receipts received from the Purchaser, will be accrued in the Road Suspense Account. This accrual will continue until the Road Suspense Account is funded to the extent required to provide the road construction fund reserve authorized by the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 14, 1978, duly adopted by a vote of seven (7) for and zero (0) against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
