

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed the request of Mrs. Marjorie Alo for a lease, and

WHEREAS, the lease is to be used to establish a Kentucky Fried Chicken Business, and

WHEREAS, a number of locations have been considered and rejected, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement to a member-type business lease at the location directly south and adjacent to the Recreation Enterprise assigned area.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent and Tribal Chairman are authorized and directed to enter into a business lease with Mrs. Marjorie Alo for approximately one and one-half (1½) acres and the area to be surveyed will be reported and on file in the Superintendent's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there be a 100 ft. setback between the eastern end of the leased area of the Right of Way for Highway 70.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the terms and conditions including tribal fees be the same as other tribal-member business leases within the reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
