

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council have discussed on three occasions, the living area for the people involved in the Living Waters Mission of Cibecue, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Montana Cromwell is agreeable to the use of Farm No. 22 and Farm No. 43 on the Farmer's Ditch of Cibecue, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is in agreement for the use of this land under a revocable permit.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Superintendent be authorized to issue a revocable permit to Mabel D. Isgrigg in the name of the Living Waters Mission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area be surveyed and boundary corners established on Farm No. 22 and Farm No. 42 on the Farmer's Ditch to include approximately 1.4 acres.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this revocable permit be issued only for the use of the mission for living quarters of mobile home.

The foregoing resolution was on August 2, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
