

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe in 1977 requested technical assistance through the Native American Development, Systems Analysis and Applied Technology (NADSAT) Agency for the upgrading of the Tribal Court System, and

WHEREAS, NADSAT recommendations include additional equipment for court record systems and extended formal training for Tribal Court Personnel at appropriate training centers, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency (ASJPA) Indian Program has available additional Federal funds for Tribal Court improvements.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes an application to ASJPA for maximum available funding to be applied toward priority requirements of the Tribal Court, including personnel training and a modern records filing system.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to take all required actions for obtaining the maximum available Federal assistance.

The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
