

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe, through its Overall Economic Development Program (OEDP), has established the following high priority goals for the benefit of its people:

1. Expanded job opportunities;
2. Improved education and training;
3. Control and beneficial use of natural resources, including water, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe must use every available source of technical assistance in developing its resources and creating jobs for its people, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Government, through the National Center for Appropriate Technology, provides grant funds for technical assistance to Indian Tribes in developing their natural and human resources.

BE IT RESOLVED the the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby approves a project to utilize the resources of the National Center for Appropriate Technology to investigate the development of new productive enterprises on the Reservation; said productive enterprises to be designed so as to provide new jobs and to develop the natural resources of the Tribe in such a way as to preserve the natural environment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman be hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to achieve the intent of this resolution.


The foregoing resolution was on September 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


