

RESOLUTION OF THE
 WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
 FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the cutting expiration date on the following described logging units will expire on December 31, 1978:

WHEREAS, these logging units are under contract to the Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has requested that the contract date be extended to permit them enough time to harvest the remaining timber that should be logged, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tribe to extend these dates to allow the Fort Apache Timber Company to finish cutting and perform other contract obligations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it consents to extend the cutting expiration dates and the contract expiration dates for other sale obligations on these logging units as follows:

The foregoing resolution was on December 13, 1978 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
