RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the people of the White Mountain Apache Tribe continue to suffer from chronic unemployment, and
- WHEREAS, the unemployment situation is due, in part, to the lack of Tribal members possessing the appropriate skills and education qualifying them for employment; and
- WHEREAS, a need for skills development and education in vocational training areas, clerical areas and other critical areas has been identified by various departments and enterprises of the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, as a result of the foregoing, the Tribal Education Office and J.O.M. proposes to seek funding for the construction and operation of a Vocational Skills Center for the White Mountain Apache Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, available funding sources require the identification of a specific parcel of land as the site for the Skills Center; and
- WHEREAS, a parcel of land comprising at least 5 acreas would adequately meet the needs of a comprehensive Vocational Skills Center and the Tribal Education Office and J.O.M. respectfully request the location recently vacated by Development Enterprise or the location presently utilized by BIA Land Operations.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that it strongly supports the creation of a Vocational Skills Center for its Reservation and it further supports the designation of an appropriate land site for the location of the Center.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to execute any and all documents necessary to secure the appropriate funding involved in the creation and operation of the Center and any and all other documents necessary thereto.
