BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to relocate the weight scale to McNary and maintain and use for the Tribe's needs.

The foregoing resolution was on January 3, 1979, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
