RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered the cost of living raises to be included in the 1979-1980 Tribal Budget, and

WHEREAS, their consideration included the Federal guidelines relative to wage increases.

BE IT RESOLVED that the cost of living increases for the Central Tribe for the 1979-1980 Fiscal Year be six percent (6%).

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
