RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council called a Special Meeting with the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority concerning some deficiences on cement work on the present housing project number: 16-25 and 16-26; and
- WHEREAS, most of the discussion and consideration were on the five (5) houses where the cement work is not meeting the policy of the Housing Authority as required by H.U.D. standard; and
- WHEREAS, the above matter has been communicated with White Mountain Apache Development Enterprise and Tribal Council as owner of the Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council will instruct the White Mountain Apache Tribe Development Enterprise to dismantle the above five (5) houses, remove the cement work and replace the houses at the expense of the subcontractor and/or Apache Development Enterprise who was warned by the Housing Authority Inspector.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council direct the Tribal Chairman to instruct the Apache Development Manager to immediately stop/abate any construction on concrete work and specifically follow all above instructions. All work shall be in compliance with Housing Authority's policy of seven (7) days to allow testing of concrete.

The foregoing resolution was on February 26, 1979, duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
