

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 74-179 of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe provides for a Tribal Health Advisory Board comprised of ten (10) members, one from each Reservation Community, and

WHEREAS, as of January, 1979, the board seat for the community of Seven-Mile has been vacant, and


WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution No. 79-15, the Seven-Mile Community people met and recommended Mrs. Lula Ivins as its representative on the Health Board, and

WHEREAS, this recommendation was accepted by the Tribal Health Board on February 26, 1979 and by the Tribal Health, Education and Welfare Committee on February 28, 1979.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe endorses the appointment of Mrs. Lula Ivins to the Tribal Health Advisory Board.

The foregoing resolution was on March 13, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
