FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the relocation of HUD homesites for David Bush, Nicodemus Riley, Ramsey Beatty, and Winona Nosie has been of concern to the Housing Authority and the Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the cost of relocation cannot be assumed by the individuals.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Bureau of Indian Affairs assume the cost of relocation of HUD homesites for David Bush, Nicodemus Riley, Ramsey Beatty, and Winona Nosie.

The foregoing resolution was on March 16, 1979, duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
