## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the community of Cibecue has a high dropout rate in the high school grades, and
- WHEREAS, the Cibecue School Board recommended to the Tribal Council the need for a Ninth Grade at the Cibecue Day School, and
- WHEREAS, it has been indicated by the Cibecue Principal that there is space for the addition of Ninth Grade.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it concurs with the desire of the Cibecue Day School Board in their request for a Ninth Grade, and hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to take the necessary action to fulfill the needs of the community.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Phoenix Area Office provide the necessary position ceiling for the Ninth Grade.

The foregoing resolution was on March 16, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of nine for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
