WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Leslie Norman suffered a loss by fire disaster on March 31, 1979 which totally destroyed their home at Seven Mile, and


WHEREAS, this disaster has caused these tribal members serious hardship.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes and directs that new housing for Mr. and Mrs. Norman be a top priority construction project under the Housing Improvement Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman to take any and all necessary actions to fulfill the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on April 04, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984)
