
RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Fort Apache Indian Agency of the Bureau of Indian Affairs will institute a "Daylight Savings Time" beginning May 21 through Labor Day, 1979 and that that said Agency Office hours will therefore be 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has considered establishing the same hours for the Tribal Business Offices.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby establishes business hours from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., beginning May 21 through Labor Day, 1979.

The foregoing resolution was on May 02, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
