RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has been recommended to the Tribal Council that a token of appreciation be offered to the employees of the Fort Apache Timber Company for their especially dedicated and successful efforts working for the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that such appreciation is appropriate because of the fruitful example set by the Fort Apache Timber Company employees in Apache productivity, and for the purpose of offering further incentives to the Fort Apache Timber Company employees in contuining in their efforts on behalf of the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, it is proposed that a barbecue be sponsored for such Fort Apache Timber Company employees.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe hereby authorizes and directs that one beef be given to Fort Apache Timber Company from the Tribal Herd, for and on behalf of the employees of the Fort Apache Timber Company, in sincere appreciation of their dedication, loyalty and efforts in making the Fort Apache Timber Company a successful operation of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on May 02, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
