RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware that Mrs. Ethel (Malone) Thompson, wife of Newton Thompson, Sr., has recently suffered the loss of her husband, who is missing following a vehicle accident in Whiteriver, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Thompson is in extreme need of financial assistance, and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Thompson is extremely concerned with the prospects of finding her husband, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds it appropriate to lend such assistance as it can to Mrs. Thompson, a tribal member.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs that Four Hundred dollars (\$400.00) worth of grocery items from the Super Market at the Whiteriver Commercial Center be given to Mrs. Thompson; said amount to be charged from the Central Tribe's Contingency Fund Budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby establishes a Search and Rescue Committee to assist Mrs. Thompson in locating her husband, Newton Thompson, Sr., until further directed by the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Committee shall be composed of:  
Reno Johnson, Sr., West Anderson, Sr., Tim C. Dye and Lynn Cody.

The foregoing resolution was on May 03, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
