


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been presented a list of tribal members requesting specific farmland assignments, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council reviewed the applications recommended for approval by the committee, and
- WHEREAS, the list of tribal members, with description of specific locations is attached.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the farmland applications as recommended by the Land Committee.

The foregoing resolution was on May 03, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
