FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, President Carter has proclaimed the month of May as the National Month for Older Americans, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to specially recognize the Tribe's honor and respect for our White Mountain Apache elders, by dedicating the month of May as the month of the White Mountain Apache Elders.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby proclaims and dedicates the month of May as the month of the White Mountain Apache Elders.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

The foregoing resolution was on May 03, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
