RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has been advised by the Tribal Education Coordinator of the present problems in allowing as many Apache children as possible to attend the Boys and Girls Summer camps, sponsored by the Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has been further advised that approximately \$54,680. additional money would be needed to adequately finance the summer youth camp program, and
- WHEREAS, said amount would provide for necessary salaries to an additional forty (40) students, and related costs involved in expanding the summer camp program, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed and considered its interest in providing programs for the Apache Youth and the benefits derived from this summer camp program.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes and directs additional funding to the Tribal Education Department in the amount of \$54,680.00 for the purposes herein setforth.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these funds are authorized by an amendment to the Central Tribe's Budget, Fiscal Year 1979-1980.

The foregoing resolution was on June 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
