## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Arizona Department of Education has requested permission to use the Williams Creek Girls Camp facility on September 28 thru 30, 1979, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the purposes of this request is for the Division of Indian Education, Arizona Department of Education, to host a State-wide Johnson O'Malley Youth Conference for approximately 150 participants, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Education Department Coordinator further advised the Council that the objectives of this conference will include giving opportunities for Indian Student leadership skills, encouraging Indian students to be involved in problem solving activities, and giving Indian students the opportunity to exchange resources and ideas leading to plans for action in Indian Education, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has discussed and determined that a rental fee for this facility in the amount of \$1,000.00 is appropriate charge for the use of the facility, electricity, water and camping areas.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby authorizes the use of the Williams Creek Girls Camp facility by the Arizona Department of Education, Divison of Indian Education, on September 28 thru 30, 1979 for the purpose of hosting the State-wide Johnson O'Malley Youth Conference.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs that a \$1,000.00 rental fee be charged for the use of this tribal facility.

The foregoing resolution was on June 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for 1 YES and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
