RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Arizona Department of Transportation is planning to construct snow fencing in the area of the intersection of State Routes 260, and 273, and
- WHEREAS, such fencing must be off the present existing right-of-way, because such fencing has to be a certain distance from the roadway to be effective, and
- WHEREAS, the bid call for construction of this fencing is planned for June, 1979 in order to have the fences in place by this winter, and
- WHEREAS, these fences will keep snow from drifting across the roadway towards Sunrise Enterprise.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe grants permission to the Arizona Department of Transportation construct snow fences, by contract, in the area of the intersection of State Routes 260 and 273.

The foregoing resolution was on June 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
