RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a tribal member, Mrs. Ataloha (Kessay) Fellers and her husband have presented her request to the Tribal Council for authorization to establish a trailer park on a land assignment currently held by Mrs. Fellers on their business assignment known as the "Bean Pot", and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Fellers has further requested additional land for this purpose, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered this request and the purposes for it, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has a policy of encouraging the establishment and operation of private businesses by tribal members on the reservation, and
- WHEREAS, any request for additional land assignments must be presented to the Land Board for survey and review and submitted to the Tribal Council for final approval.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby tentatively approves the request of Mrs. Ataloha (Kessay) Fellers, a tribal member, for authorization to establish a trailer park on her present business assignment, and subject to further consideration by the Council of her request for additional land through the Land Board.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
