WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs requests permission for an Archaeological Survey, and


WHEREAS, the survey will be for a Road Construction Project from Seven-Mile Community to I. D. Ranch, sixteen (16) miles, and

WHEREAS, this project is on the Tribe's road construction priority list for the near future.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it grants permission to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to do an Archaeological Survey from Seven-Mile to I. D. Ranch, sixteen (16) miles.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
