


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 78-204 approved November 9, 1978, approved the permit policy for Calendar Year, 1979, and

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to amend this policy to permit the salvaging by Fort Apache Timber Company of pulpwood from various land-clearing operations.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 78-204 is amended to include pulpwood sales to Fort Apache Timber Company at 5% of receipts, F.O.B., Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
