## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that there is a need to have street security lights installed in the area of the Chagache Day Care Center, to help secure the building from vandalism which has occured on numerous occasions in the past, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Finance Committee has discussed this problem and the Day Care Center Board's request for assistance in the installation cost,
- WHEREAS, there are Revenue Sharing funds available to assist the Day Care Center, and
- WHEREAS, the Finance Committee has recommended to the Tribal Council that Revenue Sharing funds be allocated for the purpose of installing security lights, in the amount of \$594.00, on the condition that the power costs for the monthly operation of these lights be paid from Day Care Center resources.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that funds in the amount of \$594.00 be allocated from Revenue Sharing funds on hand, for the purpose of installing security lights in the Day Care Center area, and provided that the power costs for the monthly operation of these lights be paid from Day Care Center resources.

The foregoing resolution was on July 10, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
