


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Department of Housing and Urban Development has met with various Indian Housing Authorities from Arizona, New Mexico, Nevada and California to discuss recommendations for a HUD Construction Management Program under Proposal Number RFP H-4288, and
- WHEREAS, representatives from the various Indian Housing Authorities have adopted a resolution rejecting HUD's construction management proposal, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has fully considered said Indian Housing Authorities' resolution attached hereto, and
- WHEREAS, the resolution referred to above also points out the concern of the Indian Housing Authorities regarding the delivery of Housing units by HUD and the need for further study to determine a better method of delivery.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe fully supports and endorses the resolution of the Indian Housing Authorities in all respects and urges that the Department of Housing and Urban Development take necessary steps to speed up the delivery of Housing Units without the necessity of burdening the tribes with further bureaucracies and insulating layers within the HUD organization.

The foregoing resolution was on February 07, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
