RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the White Mountain Apache Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has reviewed and considered numerous complaints concerning the employment of Mr. John Czeski as Assistant Manager of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise; and
- WHEREAS, such complaints indicates that Mr. Czeski is not performing his duties in the Enterprise in the best interest of the Tribe and to the satisfaction of the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, such dissatisfactory performance has been on-going and continuing over a long period of time and has resulted in a decline in morale among subordinate employees and in a lack of trust and confidence by the Tribal Council in such employee; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Enterprise that Mr. Czeski be terminated from tribal employment.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby directs the General Manager of the
 White Mountain Apache Enterprise to immediately take all
 necesary and appropriate actions to terminate Mr. John
 Czeski from all further employment with the Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 7, 1979</u>, duly adopted by a vote of nine for, zero against, one abstention, by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984).
