RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe enacted Resolution No. 79-108 on June 7, 1979, to establish the Apache Land Claim Program Committee; and
- WHEREAS, said Committee was created as a Standing Committee of the Tribal Council for the purpose of providing community representation in the Land Claims Program, and to expedite the release of all Land Claims Program funds immediately to each Community; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is appropriate to amend Resolution No. 79-108 in order to fully reflect these purposes of the Tribal Council in establishing such Standing Committee.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
 Tribe that it hereby amends Resolution No. 79-108 to include
 the specific purposes of the Apache Land Claims Committee
 to take all necessary and appropriate actions to release all
 Land Claims Program Funds immediately to each respective
 Community.

The foregoing resolution was on <u>August 7, 1979</u>, duly adopted by a vote of ten for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (Stat. 984).
