RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware that there remains a vacancy in one tribal court judgeship position, and
- WHEREAS, the recent Council nominees, under Resolution No. 79-130 have declined to accept said position, and
- WHEREAS, the need for maintaining filled judgeships at the Tribal Court still exists, in the best interests of the Tribe and its judicial operations, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed and considered alternate nominees to temporarily fill the vacant position of Associate Tribal Court Judge.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints Mr. Vincent Altaha, Sr. to temporarily fill the vacant position of Associate Judge of the Tribal Court of the White Mountain Apache Tribe with full powers and duties related thereto, and subject to any further action by the Tribal Council on full-term appointments.

The foregoing resolution was on August 14, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
