## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised and aware of numerous complaints and problems regarding poor maintenance on existing water lines to individual residences, a need for installation of new lines, and other matters relating to providing adequate water delivery service to such residences, and
- WHEREAS, such problems are of great concern to the Tribal Council and create potential health hazards to reservation residents, as well as inconvenience and hardship, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council desires that the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority and the Indian Health Service respond immediately to these problems in accordance with their relative responsibilities for water lines to residences throughout the entire reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the White Mountain Apache Utility Authority and the Indian Health Service to take all necessary actions, immediately, to replace, repair, install, or maintain water lines to the individual residences throughout the reservation in accordance with their previously established responsibilities.

The foregoing resolution was on September 05, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
