RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. J. Neal Hall, Business Manager for the Central Tribe, tendered his resignation from said position, effective October 4, 1979, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has regretfully considered the acceptance of his resignation, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council discussed the proposal of Mr. Hall to effect a transition period from October 4 to November 1, 1979 for the purpose of delegating the administrative and accounting responsibilities of his position to other tribal personnel, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that it is appropriate to employ Mr. Hall on an hourly basis through November 1, 1979 in order to undertake said transition of the workload of the Business Manager Office.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby accepts the resignation of J. Neal Hall from the position of Business Manager for the Central Tribe, effective October 4, 1979; Provided that he shall assist the Business Office in the transition of job responsibilities to other appropriate tribal personnel until November 1, and shall be compensated therefore on an hourly basis.
- The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
