

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise needs revenues to continue to improve the campgrounds, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that the cost of operation of the department continues to increase.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the fishing and camping fees on the reservation be increased to the following rates:

\$3.00 per day for adult fishing.
\$1.00 per day for juvenile fishing
\$10.00 per season for juvenile fishing.
\$3.00 per day for camping per family unit and
for season camping.

\$70.00 for the first month.
\$60.00 for the second month.
\$50.00 for the fourth month.

The foregoing resolution was on October 10, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and zero against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
