- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has a Branch Business Office located in Cibecue, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that there is a need for a new Xerox Copying Machine of appropriate size and quality, for use in the Cibecue Branch Business Office.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Central Tribal Business Office to purchase a new Xerox Copying machine appropriate in size and quality for use in the Branch Office of the Tribe at Cibecue.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said purchase shall be made from any available funds in the Central Tribal Budget, Fiscal Year 79-80.

The foregoing resolution was on November 08, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
