FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Tribal Land Office is in need of a new vehicle for use in patrolling, establishing the boundary line fencing, surveying and repairing the boundary fences and supervising the fence crews, and

WHEREAS, the Land Office budget, Fiscal Year 79-80 has sufficient funds with which to purchase such tribal vehicle.


BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the purchase of a new vehicle by the Tribal Land Office, with title taken on the name of the Tribe, from funds on hand in the Fiscal Year 79-80 Land Office Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on January 02, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
