

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised that the Whiteriver Commercial Center Enterprise proposes that a self-service, four-bay Car Wash be added to the Whiteriver Shopping Center Complex, to be located next to the Malco Service Station, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council finds that this is a needed service to the community and should be a profitable addition to the Whiteriver Commercial Center Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is advised that the total cost would be \$66,021.00, for construction and equipment, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is further advised that this proposal has been presented to the Enterprise Board and to the Finance Committee and has met with their approvals.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby approves the expenditure of \$66,021.00 by the Whiteriver Commercial Center Enterprise for the addition of a self-service, four-bay Car Wash to the Shopping Center Complex, as proposed by the Enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Council authorizes and directs an amendment to the Fiscal Year 79-80 Budget of the Whiteriver Commercial Center Enterprise in the amount of \$66,021.00 for the purpose of this expenditure.

The foregoing resolution was on January 02, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
