

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware that a Tribal Election is scheduled for the first Wednesday of April, 1980, and

WHEREAS, Tribal Election Laws require the appointment by the Council of an Election Committee to undertake the responsibilities of holding such election in accordance with tribal laws, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has reviewed recommended nominees for the 1980 Election Committee membership of five (5) persons.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby appoints the following persons to serve on the 1980 Tribal Election Committee without compensation:

1. Lonnie King
2. Kathleen Rihr
3. Barbara Thomas
4. Glorianna Dayaye
5. Marcelo Minjarez

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing persons are hereby charged with the duties and responsibilities of holding the 1980 Tribal Election in accordance with tribal laws, and to take all necessary actions to establish such election, within approved budget costs.

The foregoing resolution was on January 03, 1979 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) and (s) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
