RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is advised and aware of the growing need for a child day care center in the community of Cibecue, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Planning Office is charge with the responsibility of identifying and locating funding for tribal projects within the Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that it hereby directs the Tribal Planning Office to identify and locate available funding sources, for application by the Tribe for funding of a child day care center in the community of Cibecue.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents necessary in order to obtain such funding on behalf of the Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on January 18, 1980 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
